## HOW TO USE BLUETOOTH ON NVY LED TVs



- To Enter the Bluetooth menu, Go on Input and enter Bluetooth. In the Bluetooth menu, you will see a screen with Bluetooth symbol and No Device currently paired to Bluetooth.
- Next step, you should connect your Bluetooth device to the TV for pairing of the devices. For this you should switch on the Bluetooth on your device and look for TV device with name "Bluetooth TV". Please note that the TV should also not be paired to any Bluetooth device and also be on the Bluetooth Menu when you are trying to pair your Bluetooth device on the TV. When the Bluetooth device is paired to the TV, the name of your device will be seen on the top of the Bluetooth Menu.
- If you want to move out of Bluetooth, you can switch off Bluetooth on your Audio device or you can change the Input from Bluetooth on your TV. If you want to change the device connected to the Bluetooth TV, then you should switch off the Bluetooth in the already paired device, change the input on the TV to any other input from Bluetooth, and then go back to Bluetooth input after staying in the other input for 2 seconds or more. Now, you can follow the same process as step 2 and pair the other device to Bluetooth.
- Please note that Bluetooth TV only support Audio through Bluetooth and can enhance the sound of your Bluetooth device. Some Bluetooth devices may not connect to the TV through Bluetooth since these devices have firewalls. In such cases you should contact with the service centers of the Bluetooth device.
